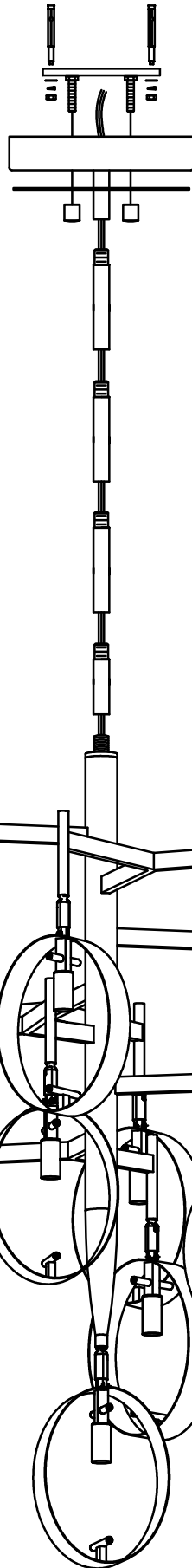


UTTERMOST

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

CAUTION

All electrical connections must be in accordance with local and National Electrical Code (N.E.C.) standards. If you are unfamiliar with proper electrical wiring connections obtain the services of a qualified electrician.

Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture, in order to prevent possible shock.

HEAVY WEIGHT FIXTURE OVER 50 LBS, MUST FOLLOW N.E.C. 314.27 (2) for heavy weight installation; Fixtures that weigh more than 50 lb shall be supported independently of the outlet box, unless the outlet box is listed for not less than the weight to be supported, and the box shall be marked by box manufacturer to indicate the maximum weight it shall support.

INSTALLATION

1. Install light bulbs and glass pieces.
2. Adjust to required rod & wire length as needed for your ceiling height for installation, remove excess if needed, leaving enough for wiring connections.

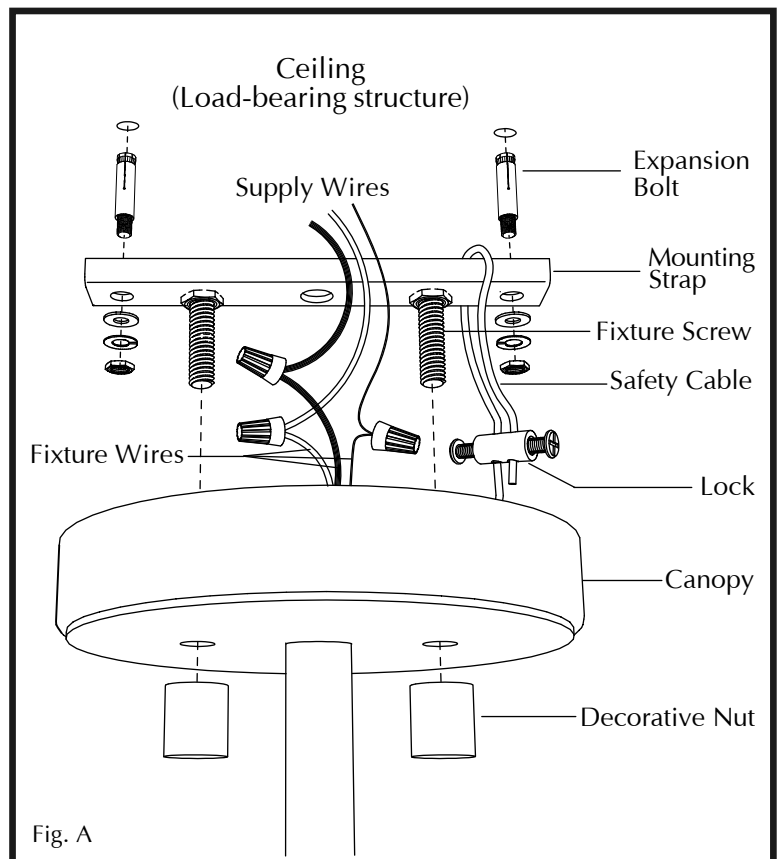
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT: FOR A SAFE AND SECURE INSTALLATION, THESE FIXTURES MUST BE INSTALLED BY MEANS OF SUPPORTS THAT ARE INDEPENDENT OF THE OUTLET BOX. YOU SHOULD USE A QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN TO INSTALL THIS FIXTURE.

NOTE: ALWAYS TURN POWER OFF BEFORE INSTALLING LIGHTING FIXTURES!

Installation (see Fig. A)

1. Disconnect power at main electrical panel before installation.
2. Drill two holes (diameter 8mm) on the ceiling (Load-bearing structure) reference mounting strap and knock the expansion bolt into the holes.
3. Attach mounting strap to heavy duty electrical box and secure with the washer and nut.
4. Assemble the fixture as shown in reference diagram.
5. Raise the fixture to ceiling and place the safety cable through the mounting strap and secure with lock and screws.



Wiring (see Fig. B)

6. Attach the fixture's wires to the power supply wires from the ceiling. Connect black to black (or smooth); white to white (or ribbed); ground to ground (green or copper). Twist the ends of the wire pairs together, then twist on a wire connector. Make sure all twists are in the same direction.
7. Place the canopy on the fixture over the mounting strap and onto the fixture screws, and secure into place using the decorative nuts.
